How to Reach

BY AIR

Gorakhpur civil airport is the nearest airport which is located around 8 km away from the city centre. Direct flights from Gorakhpur airport ply to the cities like Delhi, Varanasi, Lucknow and Kolkata and others.

BY RAIL

The Gorakhpur railway station is the main railhead and serves as the headquarters of North Eastern Railway. This railhead is well linked to major cities of the country such as Delhi, Hyderabad, Chennai, Nagpur, Varanasi, Lucknow and a lot more. The tourist can easily find a large number of auto rickshaws and taxis from outside the railway station.

BY ROAD

There are numbers of buses which provide regular services to different cities including Kushinagar (50 km), Varanasi (235 km), Lucknow (276 km) and Allahabad (339 km). Direct buses from Gorakhpur to Lucknow and other cities are easily available.



Call For Papers

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

- Those wishing to submit papers for oral or poster presentation are asked to submit an abstract or their presentation on the form provided. Abstract should be sent to the Editor AIMLTA before 30th November, 2025.
- Abstract will be pre reviewed. The selection committee will intimate the delegate, if the paper has been accepted, by 30th November, 2025.
- All presenters must register as delegate. Only registered delegates are allowed to present the paper in the conference.
- Abstract should contain, a brief title in capitals, name and affiliation of authors, summary of paper and poster. Summary should be structured with aims, methods, result and conclusion.
- Name of presenting author should be first and underlined.
- The abstract can be saved on a pen drive and printed. It should be in Arial font, size 12.

POSTER SESSION

- Poster should illustrate work relevant to conference themes and miscellaneous topics.
- An area of 120 cm (height) x 60 cm (width) will be available for each poster presentation.
- Authors should be available near their poster for discussion between 4:00 to 5:00 PM on same day.
- Poster display must indicate the title, name of the authors, aim of the study, materials and methods, result and conclusions.
- Titles of charts, drawings, photographs must be readable form a distance of 2 meters. Letters and numbers should be at least 12 mm (½ inch).
- Posters to be put up between 01:00 to 02:00 PM. on 21st December 2025 in the poster room/gallery.
- Posters to be removed after 6 PM on same day.
- Prize wining posters will be put up the auditorium foyer till the end of the conference.
- Responsibility of material needed for mounting/dismounting posters and their safety will be with the delegates.
