In other words - I do not wish for a kingdom, I do not want heaven and salvation. It is my wish to be able to help in alleviating the suffering of people."

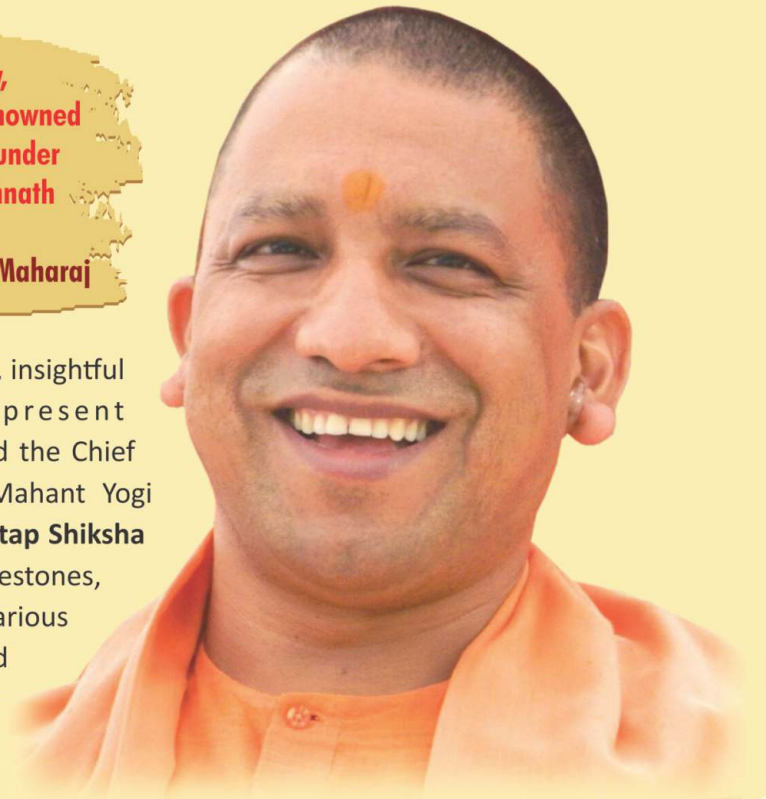

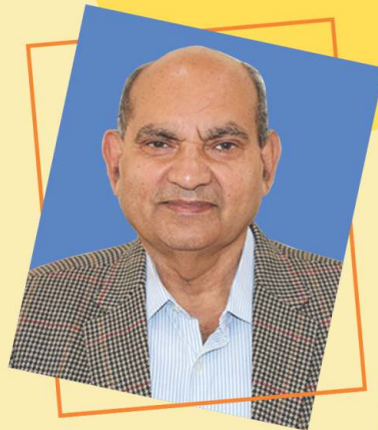

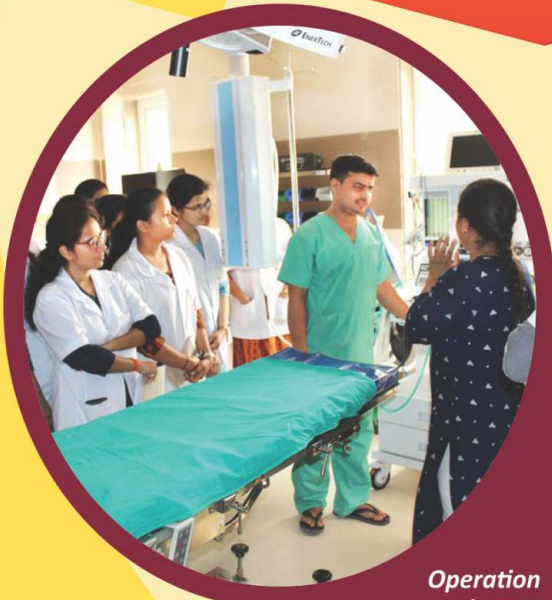
Hospital

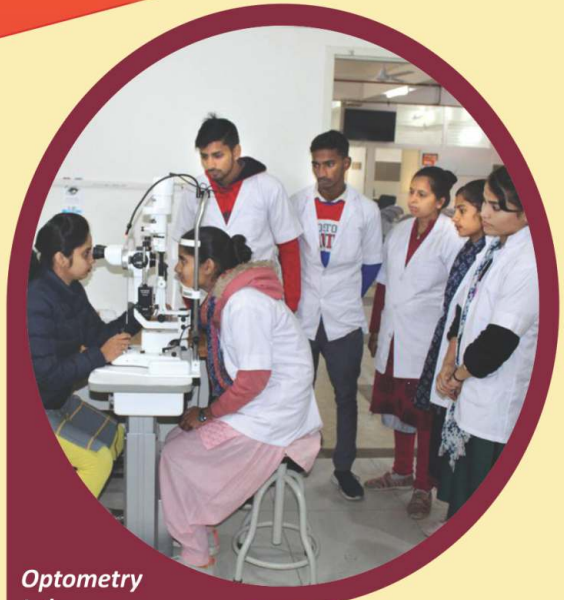

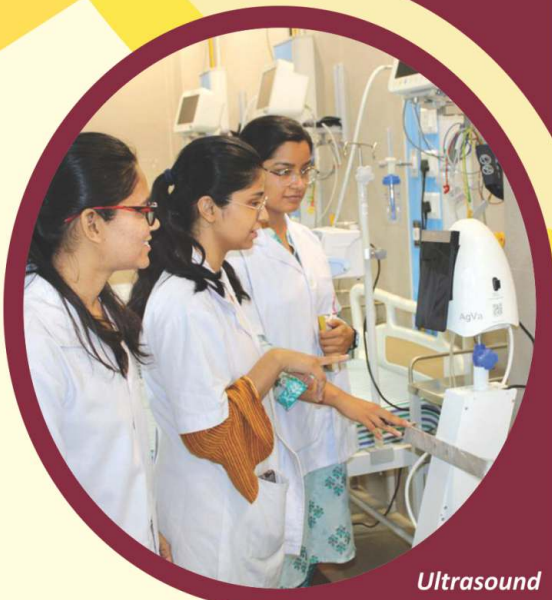

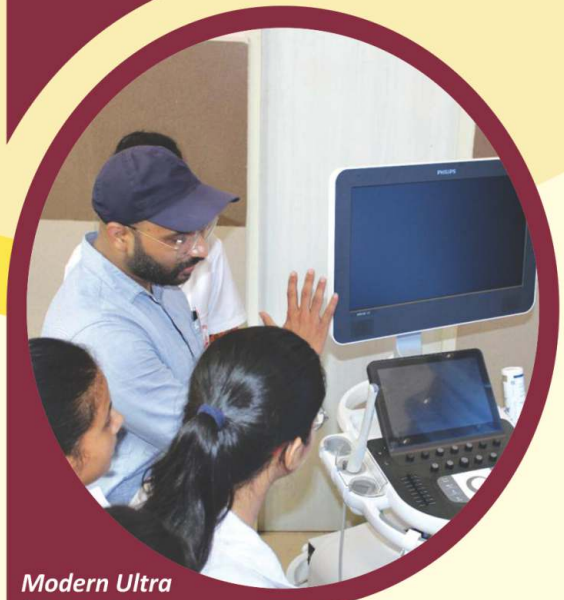

Hostels

Mahayogi Gorakhnath University Gorakhpur has two hostels, for girls and boys. The girls hostel name is Maa Pateshwari Sevashram, which has 169 rooms and a 361-student capacity with full facilities, and the boys hostel name is Mahant Gopalnath Sevashram, which has 255 rooms and a 510-student capacity with full facilities. Both the hostels are well equipped with the necessary modern and up-to-date facilities and services. The hostel rooms are fully furnished and are well equipped with Wi-Fi and other necessary electrical fittings. Every hostel has a warden and superintendent to ensure discipline and security in the hostel. First-year students are allotted double or triple sharing bedrooms depending on availability. Senior students are assigned single or double sharing rooms based on their age.

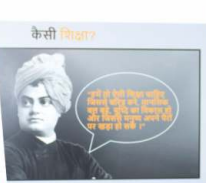

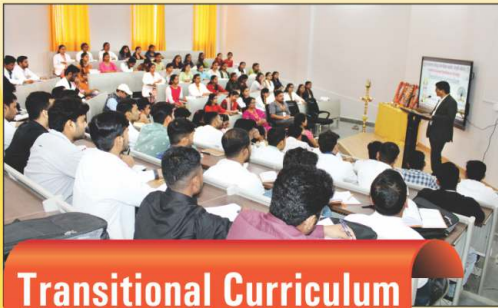

Once admission has been taken and fee deposited. No fee will be refunded.

POLICY FOR INTERNAL TRANSFER/ADMISSION TO VACANT SEAT

If there are any seat vacant after last date of admission, in that case the following criteria/rule will be applied.

- Advertisement for the vacant seats will be made internally in the students class group & university website.
- Applications will be invited from the eligible student of other programmes, provided they should fulfill the minimum eligibility criteria as laid down in the prospectus.
- A separate merit list against those vacant seats will be prepared based on the marks obtained in MGUG entrance test and the same will be shared with the students.
- If still seats are vacant admission to those vacant seat will be taken on direct basis.
 - The preference will be given to those students who appeared in entrance test but could not get admission due to any reason.
- If still seats are vacant, anyone coming directly for admission and fulfills the eligibility criteria will be given admission.

FEE PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

Admission Fee Payment

The students taking admission in any program of the university will have to pay admission fee semester wise and annually as applicable.

- **For semester system** : Fee payment dates:
 - Complete semester fee has to be paid at the time of admission.
 - For rest other semesters, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.
 - Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the semester.
- **For annual system** : Fee payment dates:
 - Complete first year fee has to be paid at the time of admission.
 - For rest other years, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.
 - Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the semester.
- There is no provision of fee payment in installment.

Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fee

- Ideally, cancellation of admission is not allowed however, in special case the same can be processed after the due approval of the Vice Chancellor.
- If admission cancellation is requested within 7-days of taking admission, a refund of fee after deduction of Rs. 5000/- will be done.
- If admission cancellation request is made after 7-days of taking admission, in that case NO FEE will be refunded.
- The above rule will not apply to admissions taken within 7-days of last date of admissions.

Hostel Allotment and Fee Payment

- Hostel will be allotted at the time of taking admission/counselling in offline mode.
- Students have to pay one-time payment of annual hostel fee at the time of hostel allotment :
For fresh admission only.
 - a) Rs. 65000/- per academic year (For Girls Hostel): This includes hostel fee & food.
 - b) Rs. 75000/- per academic year (For Boys Hostel): This includes hostel fee & food.
- Students already residing in the hostel have to pay the hostel fee **every year in the month of July**.
- Admissions to the hostel are to be renewed every academic year.
- 10% Hostel rooms are reserved for international students. In case of no international students the same will be allotted to other students.
- Basic hostel facilities/amenities will be provided for a pleasant stay in the campus.

Cancellation of Hostel and Fee Refund

- NO cancellation of hostel is admissible during a academic year.
- If hostel cancellation is requested within 7-days of hostel allotment, a refund of hostel fee after deduction of Rs. 5000/- plus mess charges will be done.
- If hostel cancellation request is made after 7-days of hostel allotment, NO FEE will be refunded.

Note : Admission to the hostel is not a right, but a privilege extended to the students.

Q-2 : What is the last date for paying registration fee?

A-2 : The registration fee of University Entrance Test 2024-25 can be paid from 1st April to 30th April 2024 through Credit/Debit Card/Net Banking/UPI.

Q-3 : What is the registration fee for various categories when filling out the University Entrance Test 2024-25 application form?

A-3 : Candidates can apply for a minimum of ONE and a maximum of FIVE courses by paying the application fee of Rs. 1000/-.

Q-4 : What is the registration fee for reserve categories applicants?

A-4 : The application fee is Rs. 1000/-.

Q-5 : What is the date for University Entrance Test 2024-25 application correction window?

A-5 : Application Form Correction window will be open from 1st May 2024 till 5th May 2024. Candidates who had earlier filled in the University Entrance Test-2024-25 application form and committed some mistakes will get the opportunity to edit the registration form.

Q-6 : What is the miscellaneous information about eligibility criteria?

A-6 : For admission in the university through University Entrance Test 2024-25, the existing policies regarding quota, category, relaxations, reservations, qualifications, subject combinations, preferences etc. of the university shall be applicable. For the eligibility criteria for admission the candidates are advised to visit the University website. Candidates are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess the eligibility criteria laid down by the University. Mere appearance in the Entrance Test or securing minimum pass percentage in the test does not entitle a candidate to be considered for admission to the Programme unless he/she fulfils the Programme wise eligibility criterion of the University.

Q-7 : Can I use my friend's email address and mobile number when registering for?

A-7 : No. The applicant should use only their own email address and mobile number as all the information will be sent on the registered e-mail ID and mobile phone.

Q-8 : What documents or certificates do I need to upload along with the Application Form?

A-8 : Candidates need to upload scanned images of photograph and signature with the Application Form. No certificates are required to be uploaded along with the Application Form at the time of online submission. The documents/certificates etc., shall be verified physically at the time of admission.

Q-9 : What are the dates of University Entrance Test 2024-25 examination?

A-9 : University Entrance Test 2024-25 examinations of the university will be held on 19th May, 21st May and 26th May 2024 dates discipline wise as mentioned uploaded on the university website.

Q-10 : When will University Entrance Test 2024-25 admit card would be available to download?

A-10 : Candidates who have successfully filled in and submitted the application form, will be able to download the admit card from the university website from 14th May 2024 onwards. The admit card carries candidate's personal information along with the examination centre and other guidelines.

Q-11 : When will University Entrance Test 2024-25 Counselling process starts?

A-11 : The University Entrance Test 2024-25 counselling or admission process shall tentatively start from 5th-14th June 2024, after the declaration of the result.

The following procedure shall be followed for selection of the candidates for admission to various programmes:

1. The minimum eligibility and number of seats for admission to various courses will remain the same as per the information brochure 2024-25. Kindly visit University Website for more details and changes/updating (if any).
2. Before filling out the Admission Application Form, the candidates are required to read the information brochures, guidelines/instructions available on the university's website carefully. Candidates will submit their Application Forms online on the University website: <https://www.mgug.ac.in> for admission to various programs, and a printout of the admission application form filled in online, along with Xerox copies of relevant documents and the receipt of the fee, should be submitted during the physical counseling. The candidates have to bring the original documents for verification.
3. Always quote your Application No. & Fee Receipt No. for reference while making correspondence regarding admission to the programs offered by this University.
4. If during the preparation of merit lists, the admission committee finds any discrepancy, the admission form may be rejected directly or an email may be sent to the candidate for online resubmission of the document within a given period of time.
5. The merit lists will be displayed on the university website as per the schedule mentioned in the information brochure or displayed on the website. No separate communication shall be sent in this regard.
6. The candidate whose name appears in the merit list has to appear for physical counseling in the concerned Department for the document verification. If, the candidate is selected, he/she has to deposit the fee online or at the university fee counter within the stipulated time, or else his/her seat will be considered vacant and a seat shall be offered to the next candidate from the merit list.
7. The mere possession of the prescribed academic qualifications does not entitle a candidate to admission to the program. Candidates would be required to fulfil all the conditions as spelled out in the information brochure.
8. The eligibility of the candidates shall be ascertained at the time of preparing the merit list; however, the admission seekers are required to ensure that they possess the prescribed qualification for the programmes for which they are seeking admission.
9. If, the concerned authorities are not satisfied with the character/antecedents of a

candidate, they may refuse to admit him/her to any course of study in the University/College in order to ensure academic standards, discipline, and peaceful atmosphere in the University.

10. If a candidate is admitted on the basis of information submitted by him/ her but at any subsequent time, it is discovered that any portion of this information is incorrect or false, the student shall be refused from the University and all fees and other dues paid till the date of such removal shall be forfeited. Candidates are banned for future admission in university.
11. All admissions are provisional and subject to verification of documents, which is approved by the competent authority.
12. No plea about the ignorance of the rules and regulations and other provisions of admission will be entertained.
13. As regards the rules of promotion etc., students will be governed by the provisions of the University ordinances.
14. The rules relating to anti-ragging, students' behavior on the campus and in the hostels as framed by the University will be applicable to and binding on all students.
