Rules and Instructions

1. Admission to the all programs offered as per above details will be taken through Combined Entrance Test conducted by the Mahayogi Gorakhnath University Gorakhpur.
2. No admission will be taken without 'Combined Entrance Test'. However, university will reserve the right for taking admission to vacant seats and the guidelines for the same will be uploaded on university website.
3. It is mandatory to apply for 'Combined Entrance Test' before the last date.
4. Once the 'Combined Entrance Test' is over the merit list of qualified candidates will be uploaded on the university website.
5. Candidates will have to appear in the counselling as per the schedule with the relevant documents and fee as mentioned in the above table. The candidate will have to deposit the fee (online) at the time of counselling.
6. Admission will be confirmed only after the fee deposited & documents verification.

You will give the exam for your 1st preference, and if seats are vacant, you can get a seat based on other preferences.

Select preferences and proceed.

Choose the preference and click next.

Step 4: Upload Photo and Signature:

Upload your recent passport-sized photo (less than 50 KB) and signature (less than 30 KB). Ensure that the photo and signature are in JPG, JPEG, or PNG format with the specified file sizes.

Review entrance exam details and check the declaration.

Enter captcha code and click "**Pay Now**".

You'll be redirected to the payment options.

Choose one and complete the payment within 5 minutes.

After payment confirmation, you'll receive the application form, which you can download for future reference.

General Guidelines and Information for Admission

The following procedure shall be followed for the selection of the candidates in admission to various programmes.

- 1.** The minimum eligibility and number of seats for the admission to various programmes will remain the same as per the information provided in the prospectus 2026-27. Kindly, visit university website for more details and updates.
- 2.** Before filling out the Admission Application Form, the candidate is required to read the prospectus carefully. Candidates will have to submit their “Application Form” through online mode only (<https://www.mgug.ac.in>) for admission to various programmes, and a printout of the submitted application form and fee receipt, should be saved for the future communication.
- 3.** If, during the entrance processes/ admission, the admission committee finds any discrepancy, the admission form may be rejected or an email may be sent to the candidate for resubmission of the admission form/ documents within a given period of time.
- 4.** The merit lists will be displayed on the university website.
- 5.** The merit lists will be prepared on the basis of performances of the candidates in the entrance test. However, the applicant will responsible to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility criteria for the programmes.
- 6.** The candidate in the merit list, will have to appear for the counselling and document verification, and thereof candidates are directed to submit two sets of photocopies of related documents with two recent passport size photographs to the admission cell during counselling. After document verification candidate will have to deposit the Programme fee online (Semester/ year wise) at the time of counselling, if fail to do so then his/her admission will be considered cancelled and the seat shall be offered to the next candidate from the merit order.
- 7.** If, the admission cell is not fully satisfied with the academic credential /character, they may deny to admit the candidate in any Programme in the University.
- 8.** If the academic qualification/ any information related to admission found incorrect/ forged in future, then admission will be cancelled and no fee will be paid back.
- 9.** All admission is provisional and subjected to document verification by the competent authority at any time during the Programme.
- 10.** No plea and ignorance of the rules and regulations and other provisions related to admission will be entertained.

11. The rules related to anti-ragging and students' behavior in the campus and in the hostels as framed by the University will be applicable to and binding on all newly admitted students up to their program completion.

Combined Entrance Test (MGUG 2026-27)

I. Entrance Test will comprise of 100 questions (01 mark each) of 2 hours duration, unless otherwise mentioned and will consist of multiple-choice questions (questions with one correct answer). There will be no negative marking. The details/instructions for attempting the question paper will be given in the booklet/question paper at the time of Entrance Test.

II. The entrance examination pattern for the Combined Entrance Test will be consistent across all programmes:

* 60% of the questions will be based on the syllabus of the first preference opted Programme.

* 20% of the questions will be covered from General studies, Current Affairs, Aptitude and Reasoning.

* 20% of the questions will be based on the Indian Knowledge-system, especially focusing on the epics of Ramayan and Mahabharat.

III. The candidate will have to report at the concerned examination center at least one hour before the commencement of the Combined Entrance Test. The entrance tests will be held as per schedule given in the prospectus/notification available on the university website. However, the university has the right to change the schedule of entrance test. date of declaration of the result, for such updates, candidates are requested to visit university website (<https://www.mgug.ac.in>) frequently.

IV. If a candidate found involved in using any unfair means during the Combined Entrance Test, his/her candidature shall be cancelled immediately.

V. There shall be no provision for re-evaluation/rechecking of answer sheet of the Combined Entrance Test 2026-27.

Reporting of the Admitted Candidate in the concerned Department

Candidates who are provisionally admitted must report to their respective department/Faculty for further information.

POLICY FOR INTERNAL TRANSFER/ADMISSION TO VACANT SEAT

If there is any seat vacant after the last date of admission, in that case the following criteria/rule will be applied.

- Notification for the vacant seats will be made and published on the university website.
- A merit list against vacant seats will be prepared on the basis of marks obtained in MGUG-combined entrance test.
- For internal transfer notification will be made and this will be accord with eligibility criteria required for taking admission in other programs.

FEE PAYMENT AND REFUND POLICY

Admission Fee Payment

The students taking admission in any program of the university will have to pay admission fee semester wise and annually as applicable.

For semester system: fee payment dates:

Complete semester fee has to be paid at the time of admission.

For rest other semester, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.

Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the semester.

For annual system: fee payment dates:

Complete first year fee has to be paid at the time of admission.

For rest other years, complete fee has to be paid as per timeline given by the university.

Examination fee has to be paid at the time of filling of online examination form during the

There is no provision of fee payment in installment.

Cancellation of Admission and Refund of Fee

Ideally, cancellation of admission is not allowed however, in special case the same can be processed after the due approval of the vice chancellor.

If admission cancellation is requested within 7-days of taking admission, a refund of fee after deduction of Rs. 5000/- will be done.

If admission cancellation request is made after 7-days of taking admission, in that case NO FEE will be refunded.

The above rule will not apply to admissions taken within 7-days of last date of admissions.
